Proposal	Construction of a single storey rear extension comprising removal of walls forming kitchen, office and utility to form open plan kitchen and sun lounge

Whilst the Parish Council had no concerns with this development in principle it **objected** to this application on the grounds that the proposed pitched roof is not in keeping with the character of the original Art Deco style of the property. Although pre-planning advice had been sought, it appears that the Officer advice against the incorporation of a pitched roof had been ignored. The Parish Council would have no objections if the rear extension was of a flat roof design in keeping with the rest of the house.

The Parish Council had hard copies of these plans but comments were made that it was very difficult if not impossible to read these on line due to their poor presentation.

Additional information about car parking received from the Planning Officer was considered. The Parish Council confirmed that it did **not object** to this planning Application but wished to highlight the parking issues in this location.

It was noted that the agent and owner have stated that the garage has never been used as such despite comments on 'Trip Advisor' from paying guests indicating otherwise; such as "parking in the garage was a bit tricky" and "least liked the garage". There are also comments posted about permanent residents putting out cones and crates to stop visitors to 6 Church Cottages parking in front of their house.
