**Public Question Time:** Members of the public raised the following points & issues:

- There is a dark area on Harbour Road, there is a need for an additional street light between 10B and No's 24- 26 Harbour Road. County Councillor G Renner-Thompson agreed to look into this matter.
- What is the programme for the removal of the old sodium lights and when will the review take place, which is scheduled to take place once the programme is complete. County Councillor G Renner-Thompson agreed to look into this matter.
- The white lines at the Swinhoe crossroads (B1340 & C69) need to be renewed. County Councillor G Renner-Thompson agreed to look into this matter.
- The National Trust have closed off the beach at the Nanny and created an alternative route. Part of the route is ok, on the second part up to the sand dunes it is uneven, hilly and there is a barbed wire on top of the fence on the pedestrian side of the footpath. The resident asked if the issue could be raised with the National Trust as well as asking if notices can be erected saying "keep dogs on leads at all times". The Clerk agreed to report the issues to the National Trust.
- Why did Anne-Marie Trevelyan MP, County Councillor G Renner-Thompson and another have a meeting at St Helen's field. County Councillor G Renner-Thompson agreed to reply in his County Councillor report later this evening.
